Artwork Guidelines






Bleed

If your artwork has elements that go off the edge of the page, please add 3mm bleed around the document, without this your print may have white edges.

For example, for a standard business card (85mm x 55mm), your artwork would be 91mm x 61mm.





File formats explained



RASTER

.jpg

usually used for photographic images loses quality when scaled up to more than 100%

doesn't support transparency

.png

same as above but supports transparency

.gif

same as above but lower quality

.psd

layered file that has been created in Adobe Photoshop



VECTOR

.eps

usually used for logos & illustrations

can be scaled to any size without losing
 quality

supports transparency

.ai

layered working file editable in Adobe Illustrator

.pdf

vector elements such as logos & illustrations remain vectors and can be scaled up

embed fonts into the document so they display correctly

preferred file format when printing documents

Resolution

DPI (dots per inch)

High resolution - 300dpi

Ideal for printing

Medium resolution - 150-250dpi

Low resolution - 72-100 dpi

Fine for viewing on screen

Margins

We recommend you leave at least 5mm between any text/ images and the edge of the document. Any elements which are closer than this could risk being cut off.
